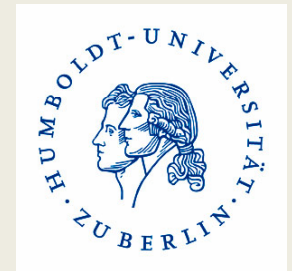

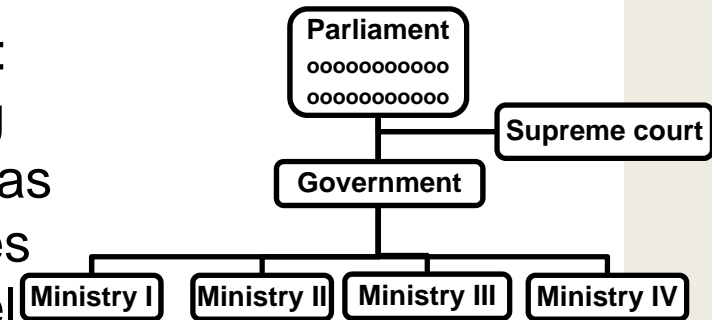

A Three-Level Model of Societal Change

INSTITUTIONAL LEVEL

Law-making activities:
Setting legally binding rules and regulations as framework for activities on organizational level



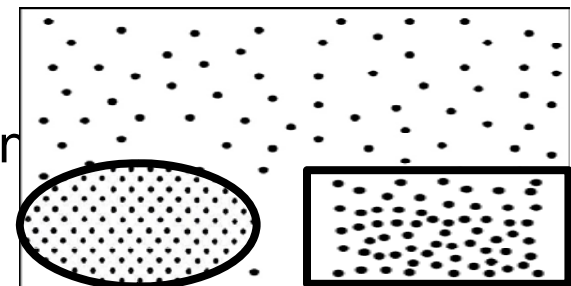
ORGANIZATIONAL LEVEL

Organizational activities:
Defining regulations for coordination of activities on the technical level

- Governmental organizations
- Business organizations
- Political organizations
- Civil society organizations

TECHNICAL LEVEL

Operative activities:
Production and consumption of goods and services (individuals, families, groups, companies, schools, etc.)


INSTITUTIONAL LEVEL

listen; draft, debate, pass law




ORGANIZATIONAL LEVEL

studies, partners, strategy, compromise, agreements

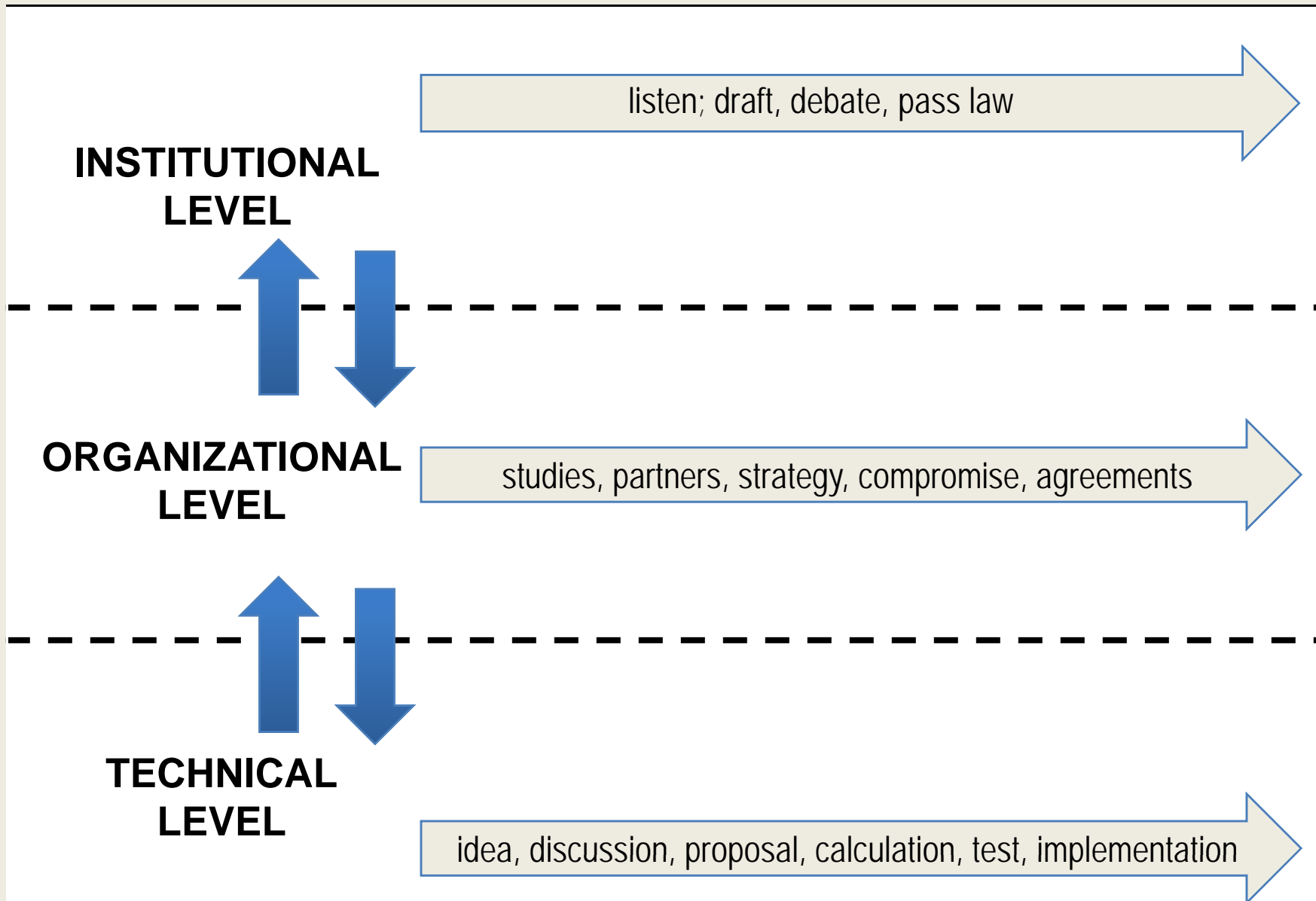


TECHNICAL LEVEL

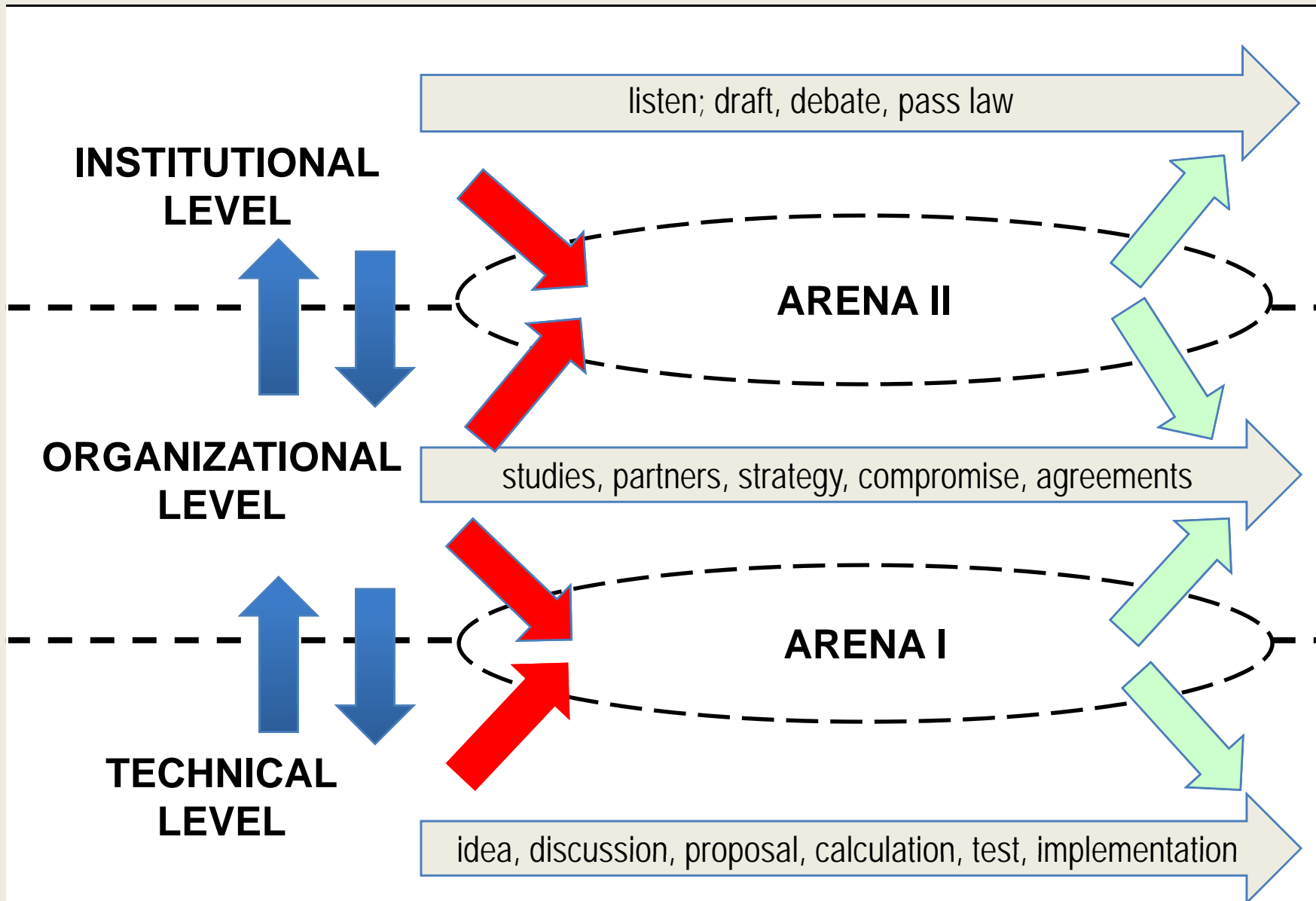
idea, discussion, proposal, calculation, test, implementation
