Delegation from the Hounslow-Ramallah Twinning Association Visited MAS



Monday, 21 March 2016, Ramallah. Today a delegation from the Hounslow-Ramallah Twinning Association (HRTA) visited the Palestine Economic Policy Research Institute (MAS). The delegation to MAS, which included several high-level guests from Hounslow, was headed by the Mayor of the London Borough of Hounslow Councillor Nisar Malik, who is also a joint Honorary President of the HRTA.

Dr. Nabeel Kassis, Director General, and Mrs. Daniela Andreevska, Project Coordinator, received the delegation, and briefed the guests on recent socio-economic developments in Palestine as a reflection of the political situation.

The delegation is currently on an official visit to Palestine to revive the relationship between Hounslow and Ramallah, which were officially twinned back in 1988, as well as to learn more about the history of and the current situation in Ramallah in specific and Palestine in general and to explore new opportunities for cooperation.
